- Since the scholarship spots are adjusted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs each semester, the final confirmation will be announced along with the admission results.



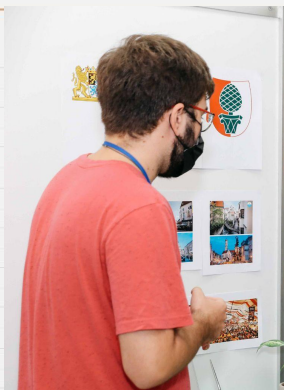
